and as the U.S. principal party in interest ("USPPI") hereby appoints **DHL EXPRESS (USA), INC.** and its heirs, assigns, officers, employees, and/or specifically authorized agents (collectively "Grantee") to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the Grantor for and in the name, place and stead of said Grantor, in the United States, either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means, to:

Giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said Grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents;

This power of attorney to remain in full force and effect:

Grantor appoints and authorizes Grantee as agent to act within the territory as lawful forwarding agent and to sign or endorse export documents and transmit manually electronically export information (i.e., commercial invoices, bill of lading, insurance certificates, certificates of origin, and any other document) necessary for the completion of an export on Grantor's behalf as may be required under law or regulation relating to export or export controls in the territory and to appoint forwarding agents on Grantor's behalf. Grantor specifically authorizes Grantee as its agent to file Electronic Export Information in the Automated Export System on Grantor's behalf, and to transmit export information in a manifest to U.S. Customs and Border Protection;

The Grantor certifies that necessary and proper documentation to accurately transmit the information electronically as authorized agent for export control to U.S. Customs and Border Protection and the U.S. Census Bureau is and will be provided to the said Grantee. The Grantor further understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any U.S. laws or regulations on exportation and agrees to be bound by all statements of said authorized agent based upon information or documented provided by the Grantor to said Grantee authorized agent;

Grantor acknowledges receipt of DHL's Terms and Conditions of Carriage governing all transactions between the Parties. Signatory certifies that he/she has full authority to execute this power on behalf of the Grantor.
