

## DHL Express Excepted Quantity Restrictions

Very small quantities of dangerous goods may be transported in such a manner that they are exempt from the marking, labeling and documentation requirements of the IATA dangerous goods regulations. When transport in accordance with IATA DGR Section 2.7, such goods are called 'Dangerous Goods in Excepted Quantities'. The Excepted Quantities (EQ) label must be completed and affixed to each package prepared under the IATA regulations.

The description field on the DHL Express air waybill must include: "**Dangerous Goods in Excepted Quantities**". The following list of countries are approved EQ destinations:
