

## DHL Express Full Carriage Dangerous Goods Restrictions

DHL Express accepts full-carriage dangerous goods that require shipping papers door-to-door to certain international destinations. All shipments must be prepared in accordance with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Technical Instructions for the Safe Transportation of Dangerous Goods by Air. IATA Dangerous Goods regulations may be used as a supplement.

DHL Express currently ships full-carriage dangerous goods to/from the following countries. Dangerous goods service may be limited to certain quantities and to specific IATA codes in certain countries where indicated. For international dangerous goods that DHL Express cannot carry, DHL Global Forwarding (DGF) may be to provide service. Contact DGF customer service at 1-800-426-5962.
