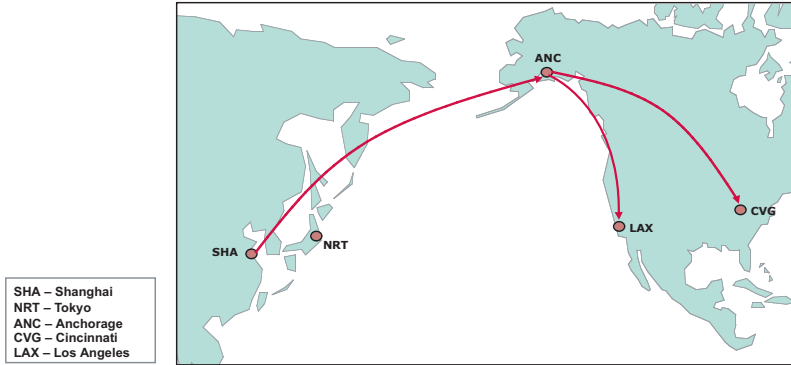

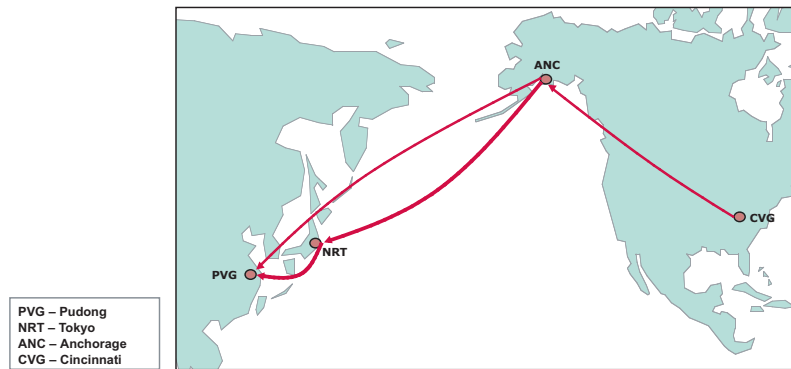
Inbound – 1 Day Delivery from China to U.S.

Outbound – 3 Day Delivery from U.S. to China

All shipments to China East Area* are delivered by the 3rd business day**.
